

Catasetum tenebrosum



Native of: Southeastern Ecuador & eastern Peru

Habitat: High altitude 1200 to 1900 meters, cool growing on trees and rocks

Description: Produces many flowers, the sepals & petals are dark wine red and the heart shaped lip red to yellowish green.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar plants warm (min. 15°C) wet & well fed in the summer & dryish in winter in pots. High light all year round.

Flowering season: March to October

Flask to flowering approx: 5yrs.
