

Cymbidium insigne



Native of: Vietnam, China & Northern Thailand

Habitat: High altitude 1000 to 1700 meters, cool growing in sandy soil in low, open woodland.

Description: Medium to large plant 5 to 15 flowers on a meter long spike. Faint scent. Winter/Spring flowering (Photograph is parent plant)

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this cool (min. 10°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter in pots. A lot of cymbidium growers put mature plants outside in a shady place during summer.

Flowering season: Winter- Spring

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
