

# Dendrobium loddigesii



**Native of:** Laos & Southern china

**Habitat:** Small epiphyte that spreads like a mat over the surface of branches and rocks and forms a large mass of stems.

**Description:** This is a low spreading plant that makes a mass of 10cm pseudobulbs that produce 1 or 2 flowers each in late spring.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At School we grow this plant mounted and cool (minimum 10°C). We spray it daily in the summer but keep it dryish in the winter and put it under artificial light to help it flower well.

**Flowering season:** Late spring

**Flask to flowering approx:** 2yrs.
