

# Encyclia randii



**Native of:** North to western Brazil and Paraguay

**Habitat:** hot rainforest lowlands at elevations of 10 to 300 meters

**Description:** This small to medium sized, hot growing, light loving, epiphytic species has 60cm flower spikes with up to 20 flowers. This species has the largest flower of the Encyclia genus 6cm across

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar species warm (min. 15°C) in pots with good light.

**Flask to flowering approx:** 5yrs.
