

# Epidendrum proligerum



**Native of:** Brazil

**Habitat:** We have found this species growing as an epiphyte in open forest on mountain ridges at about 1300m. This habitat is humid and receives regular mists.

**Description:** A small plant with thin pseudobulbs up to 30cm long with two or three leaves near the top. Flowers are in groups of four to six each about 2.5 cm across.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this species cool (min.10°C) in pots and mounted with a good supply of water throughout the year.

**Flowering season:** Autumn

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3yrs.
