Epidendrum stamfordianum



Native of: Mexico to Venezuela

Habitat: Epiphytic in open forests up to 600m.

Description: This is a medium sized plant that is unusual for Epidendrums as its flower spikes come from the base of the pseudobulbs. The notable heavily spotted flowers are 4cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species warm (min.15°C) in pots with good light.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
