

Listerostachys pertusa



Native of: Central and West Africa

Habitat: Epiphytic in evergreen forest from 500-600m altitude.

Description: A small plant that produces dense spikes of tiny white flowers. Although the flowers are small they all open together making an attractive sight.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light but we have heard it also grows well at lower temperatures.

Flowering season: June

Flask to flowering approx: 2yrs
