

# Miltonia-cuneata



**Native of:** Brazil

**Habitat:** We have found this species growing as an epiphyte in primary forest on at about 1300m. Plants form large colonies

**Description:** A medium sized plant with 40cm leaves and upright flower spikes 50cm long with up to fifteen 4cm flowers.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this species cool (min.10°C) in pots with a good supply of water throughout the year.

**Flowering season:** Spring

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3-4yrs.
