

Odontoglossum praestans



Native of: Colombia to Peru

Habitat It grows on exposed, brush covered slopes in wet montane forests at an elevation of 1600-1800 meters.

Description: This is a small sized, epiphytic species that produces spikes of 6-9 flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this cool (min.10°C) and well shaded and water throughout the year.

Flowering season: Spring

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
