

Oncidium baueri (syn Oncidium bolivianum)



Native of: Brazil, Peru, Bolivia, Ecuador

Habitat: An epiphyte in wet forest up to 1200m

Description: A large plant with leaves up to 75cm long and branched flower spikes up to 3m long carrying many 3cm flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min 15°C) in a pot with good light.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 4-5yrs.

Seedling source: Commercial nursery
