

Paphiopedilum kolopakingii



Native of: Borneo

Habitat: Terrestrial or lithophyte growing from 600 to 650m altitude. This plant was discovered in 1982.

Description: This is a large growing Paph with leaves up to 60cm long and flower stems up to 70cm long with up to a maximum of 14 flowers opening together. The flowers can be 10cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species hot (min.18°C) through out the year in medium light.

Flowering season: Variable

Flask to flowering approx: 6yrs.

Seedling source: Commercial nursery
