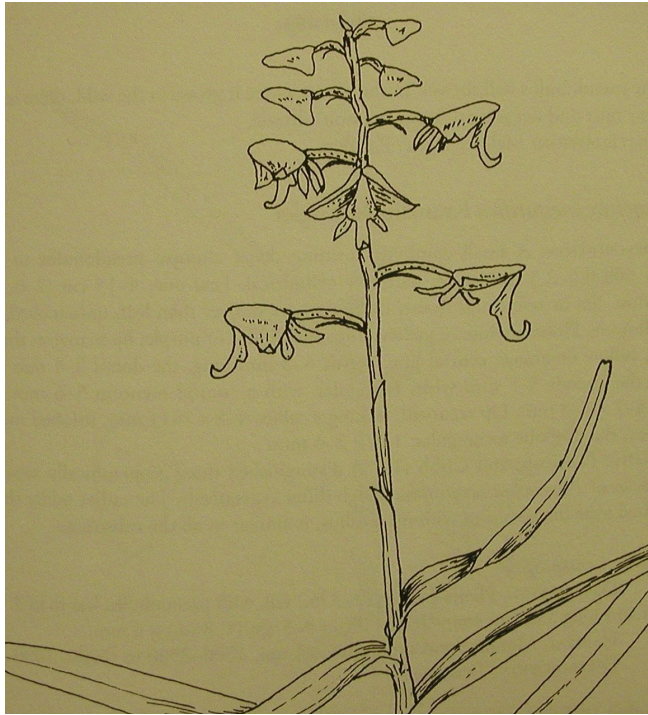


Polystachya bifida



Native of: Cameroon, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Nigeria, Rwanda, Zaire & Sao Tome.

Habitat: An epiphyte in evergreen forest from to 2500m.

Description: Medium sized plant stems up to 40cm high, flowers 10-20cm long 10-20 primrose scented flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min15°C) in partial shade. They are kept wet in the summer but then dry after the leaves fall.

Flowering season: spring

Flask to flowering approx. 4yrs
