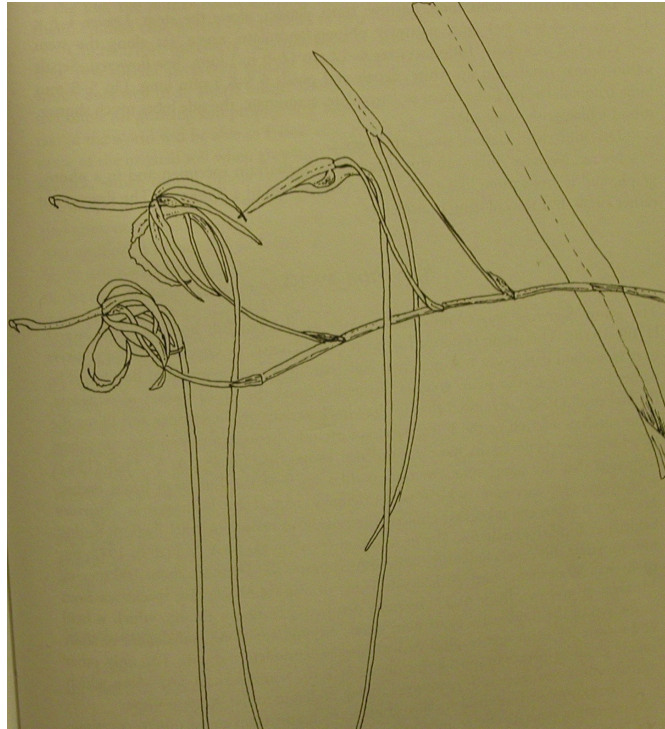


# Rangaeris-schliebenii



**Native of:** Tanzania

**Habitat:** Riverine and submontane forest 400-1400m.

**Description:** Stems fairly short, to 10cm long; roots long and stout, 4-5 cm in diameter. Leaves numerous, borne in a fan.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light in a pot or basket, but needs to be suspended or stood on another pot when flowering as spur is long.

**Flowering season:** December & January

**Flask to flowering approx.** 3yrs
