

Sophranitella violacea



Native of: Brazil

Habitat: An epiphyte found from 600-1000m in humid forest.

Description: A real miniature of the Cattleya family, with bulbs up to 3cm and a single thin leaf to 5cm and one 4cm flower from the top of each new bulb.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species coolish (min12°C) in good light and mounted on bark.

Flowering season: Early spring

Flask to flowering approx: 3yrs
