

Aerangis coriacea



Native of: Kenya and Tanzania

Habitat: Epiphytic at low level on tree trunks in shade in upland forest often near a river from 1300 to 2300m

Description: small plant with 15cm thick leaves arching flower stems carrying up to 22 flowers which are white tinged with pink or green. The flowers have long curving spurs.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it warm (min15°C) in low light but its range implies it could grow cooler.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 2-3 yrs
