

Aerangis distincta



Native of: Malawi

Habitat: At low level on tree trunks in shade in riverine or evergreen forest from 700 to 1700m.

Description: small plant with 15cm leaves and large white flowers with salmon pink tips to petals and sepals and long pink spurs. From 2 to 5 flowers on each stem.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light but its range implies it could grow cooler.

Flowering season: winter or early spring

Flask to flowering approx: 2yrs
