

Aerangis mystacidii



Native of: South & west Africa

Habitat: Twig epiphyte overhanging water in riverine forest or in wet evergreen forest. From 60 to 1800 meters.

Description: miniature plant small white flowers from 3 to 24 on each stem. Young plants produce a few flowers at a time while mature plants are covered in flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we find that this is not a fussy plant. We grow it mounted but it would also grow in a pot. We grow it hot (min18°C) but it should cope cooler than this. In the wild it grows in low light.

Flowering season: summer

Flask to flowering approx: 1yr
