

# Aerangis somalensis



**Native of:** South & West Africa

**Habitat:** Epiphyte in rather dry woodland from 1000 to 1800m.

**Description:** Small plant with thick roots & medium white flowers with a pink tinge. From 2 to 17 flowers on each stem.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar plants mounted and grow it hot (min18°C). It needs more light than most aerangis and a dry spell in the winter is recommended.

**Flowering season:** summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3yrs
