

Angraecum dasycarpum



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: Epiphytic in Eastern Madagascar

Description: miniature plant with relatively large 1cm white flowers. The plant has small branching stems that form into a specimen over time.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species mounted on cork bark and grow it warm with a minimum of 18°C

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 2yrs.
