

# Angraecum subulatum



**Native of:** West Africa

**Habitat:** Epiphytic in dense forest

**Description:** medium size plant with small 1cm white flowers.  
The plant is usually pendulous with leafy stems up to 50cm long.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar species mounted on cork bark and grow it warm with a minimum of 18°C in heavy shade.

**Flowering season:** ?

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3yrs.
