

# Aspasia lunata



**Native of:** Brazil

**Habitat:** Epiphyte in seasonally dry forest over a wide altitude range.

**Description:** A small plant with a leaves up to 30cm long and showy long lasting flowers on short stems carrying one to three flowers.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this plant in a pot and warm (min15°C) in good light.

**Flowering season:** autumn

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3 Years.
