

# Cattleya luteola



**Native of:** Brazil, Peru, Ecuador and Bolivia

**Habitat:** Growing on trees in warm forest up to 600m, usually semi-shaded and near rivers.

**Description:** Medium plant with 15cm pseudobulbs and a 20cm leaf that produces several flowers on a short inflorescence each 5cm across.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar species warm (min 15°C) and in pots.

**Flowering season:** Early Spring

**Flask to flowering approx:** 4yrs.

**Seedling source:** Peruflorea
