

Laelia tenebrosa



Native of: Brazil

Habitat: An epiphyte or lithophyte in coastal areas they were once said to grow even in the sands along the beaches.

Description: A large plant up to 45cm high with 18cm waxy flowers and 2-5 on a stem.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species warm (min15°C) in good light , in pots.

Flowering season: May and July

Flask to flowering approx: 5yrs

Seedling source: Private Grower
