

Angraecum calceolus



Native of: Madagascar and Comoro, Mascarene and Seychelles islands

Habitat: Not a fussy orchid, it is found as an epiphyte from 100 to 1800m altitude.

Description: A small plant with 2cm greenish flowers on spikes of up to 6 flowers..

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species in pots or mounted and warm (min 15°C). It is reputed as being easy to grow and we have found this at Writhlington.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx. 2yrs.
