

Paphiopedilum appletonianum



Native of: China, Thailand, Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia

Habitat: Terrestrial growing in leaf litter and mossy boulders in shady places in forest from 400 up to 1500m altitude.

Description: A medium sized plant with leaves up to 20cm long with tall 30cm flower stems a single flower 6-10cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species hot (min.18°C) through out the year in medium light.

Flowering season: Autumn / spring

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
