

Cymbidium Eburneo-lowianum



Hybrid: Registered in 1889 this is the primary hybrid between *Cymbidium eburneum* and *Cymbidium lowianum*.

Habitat: The parent species come from cool forests above 1500m in the Himalayas.

Description: A large plant with dark green leaves up to 90cm long and arching spikes carrying up to 10 flowers each 12cm across. This early hybrid has grace and elegance often missing in modern hybrids.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this cool (min.10°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter.

Flowering season: Spring
