

Coelogyne flaccida



Native of: Nepal, Sikkim, Burma, Laos and China

Habitat: An epiphyte in forest at around 1000-2000m.

Description: A medium sized plant with long lasting fragrant 4cm flowers with up to 10 on 25cm arching spikes.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this cool (min.10°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter.

Flowering season: Early Summer
