

# Coelogyne longipes



**Native of:** Nepal, Sikkim, Burma, Laos and China

**Habitat:** An epiphyte in forest at around 1000-2000m.

**Description:** A large plant with a branching rhizome and spikes from the top of bulbs which continue to grow and flower for several years. The flowers are brown and cream and 3cm across in groups of about 6.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this cool (min.10°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter.

**Flowering season:** Early Summer

**Plant source:** Writhlington division
