

Dendrobium suffusum



Native of: Australia

Habitat: A lithophyte in seasonally dry forest.

Description: This is a natural hybrid between *Dendrobium kingianum* and *Dendrobium gracilicaule*. A medium sized plant that grows into a specimen quite quickly. Pseudobulbs up to 40cm high carry spays of many 1cm flowers with a lovely fragrance. This clone is very floriferous and before dividing won two CCCs.

Cultivation Guidance: At school this species succeeds cool (min.10°C) good light with lots of water in the summer but dryish in the winter.

Flowering season: Spring
