

# Epidendrum porpax



**Native of:** Central America and Cuba

**Habitat:** Epiphytic on trees in forest up to 1000m.

**Description:** This is a dwarf species that grows to form a specimen over time which can be covered in the long lasting, glossy 3cm flowers.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this species warm (min.15°C) in pots or mounted on bark with good light but from its range could grow a little cooler.

**Flowering season:** all year
