

Jumellea comorensis



Native of: Grand Comoro Island

Habitat: An epiphyte in wet forest at around 500m.

Description: A smallish plant with a branching habit and single white flowers with long spur that come from the leaf nodes.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min.15°C) and mounted on bark.

Flowering season: On and off all year

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs

Seedling source: Writhlington School (Mother plant shown)
