

Laelia lundii



Native of: Brazil and Bolivia

Habitat: An epiphyte 600-1100m on tall trees in humid forest.

Description: A miniature of the Cattleya family, with bulbs up to 6cm and a single leaf to 10cm with comparatively large flowers up to 9cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species coolish (min12°C) in good light , both mounted on bark and in pots.

Flowering season: Autumn

Seedling source: Commercial grower
