

Oncidium incurvum



Native of: Central America

Habitat: Epiphyte in evergreen forest to 1300 to 2100m.

Description: This medium sized plant produces spikes up to 5ft long branching spikes with many 3cm pink flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we succeed with this species in (min10 °C) conditions and in a pot.

Flowering season: Early Summer
