

# Barkeria findleyana



**Native of:** Costa Rica

**Habitat:** growing epiphytically on trees from 500 to 1800m altitude in seasonally dry forest.

**Description:** Medium sized plant with stems up to 50cm and a terminal flower spike carrying as many as twenty flowers each 5cm across. The plant grows a mass of thick roots. This species flowers on young plants.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this species warm (min 15°C) in medium light and mounted. The seedlings root profusely making this an easy species to grow mounted

**Flowering season:** Autumn

**Flask to flowering approx:** 2-3yrs.
