

Cymbidium erythrostylum



Native of: Vietnam

Habitat: High altitude about 1500 meters.

Description: Medium sized plant with 5 to 10 flowers on a 40cm long spike. Flowers are 7cm across and long lasting. This clone is autumn flowering though we have another plant that flowers in the late spring and summer. (Photograph is parent plant)

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this cool (min.10°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter in pots. A lot of cymbidium growers put mature plants outside in a shady place during summer.

Flowering season: Autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
