

Cattleya intermedia alba



Native of: Brazil

Habitat: Atlantic coastal forest and generally grows as an epiphyte but can be found growing as a terrestrial and or a lithophyte. This is the alba form of a species with lots of colour variations.

Description: medium bifoliate Cattleya with 3-9 large sized flowers.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species warm (min 15°C). Its natural habitat suggests it needs good light.

Flowering season: Autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 6yrs.
