

# Coelogyne dayana



**Native of:** Borneo

**Habitat:** An epiphyte in wet forest from 300 to 2000m.

**Description:** This is a large growing plant with leaves up to 80cm long and pendulous flower stems produced from new growths that can be one metre long and carry sixty 5cm flowers. The plant can make a good specimen.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this warm (min. 15°C) wet in the summer dryer in winter in pots or moss filled baskets. We feed well during the growing season and keep a eye out for the flower spikes so that they can hang freely.

**Flowering season:** Spring
