

Dendrobium cucumerinum



Native of: Eastern Australia.

Habitat: Epiphyte found on the main branches of river oaks which line stream banks.

Description: The cucumber orchid receives its name from its gherkin shaped leaves which are attached to a creeping rhizome. small clump forming plant.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species cool (min.6°C) and mounted on bark slab, we spray them once daily in the summer but much dryer in the winter.

Flowering season: spring

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
