

Dendrobium otaguroanum



Native of: Papua New Guinea and Irian Jaya.

Habitat: Epiphyte found in cloud forest from 1500 to 2200m.

Description: A small growing plant with slender pseudobulbs about 25cm long topped with two or three leaves. The flowers are borne on short stems with up to ten flowers each 4cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species coolish (min.10-12°C) in pots and mounted on bark slab and kept damp.

Flowering season: Any time

Flask to flowering approx: 3yrs.
