

# Epidendrum paniculatum



**Native of:** Common throughout the American tropics

**Habitat:** Terrestrial or epiphytic on trees in wet tropical forest up to 2000m.

**Description:** Has a branched flower spike with many small green and white flowers. It flowers young but in time grows to be a tall plant up to 1m tall. The plant pictured is from the same mother flask!.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this species warm (min.15°C) in pots with good light but from its range could grow a little cooler.

**Flowering season:** Summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 3yrs.
