

# Epidendrum stamfordianum



**Native of:** Mexico to Venezuela

**Habitat:** Epiphytic in open forests up to 600m.

**Description:** This is a medium sized plant that is unusual for Epidendrums as its flower spikes come from the base of the pseudobulbs. The notable heavily spotted flowers are 4cm across.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this species warm (min.15°C) in pots with good light.

**Flowering season:** Summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 4yrs.
