

Holcoglossum subuliferum



Native of: Vietnam

Habitat: An epiphyte that grows at around 1600 meters.

Description: Blooms with an arching, branching inflorescence which carries numerous thinly textured, crystalline white 5cm blooms and terete leaves.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min. 15°C) and mounted on bark its range suggests it could grow cooler.

Flowering season Spring & Summer

Flask to flowering approx. Probably 4-5 years
