

Jumellea arborescens



Native of: Central Madagascar

Habitat: An epiphyte or lithophyte that grows at around 1400 meters in moss forests.

Description: Medium sized plant which has single white flowers with long spur that come from the leaf nodes.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min. 15°C) and mounted on bark its range suggests it could grow cooler.

Flowering season: Mid Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs
