

# Jumellea filicornoides



**Native of:** South and East Africa

**Habitat:** Riverine forest and wet woodland on rocks and trees from 350 to 1700m.

**Description:** Stems up to 40cm high with alternate 10cm leaves carry single violet scented flowers 4cm across.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar species warm (min.15°C) and mounted on bark its range suggests it could grow cooler.

**Flowering season** Summer

**Flask to flowering approx.** 4yrs
