

# Laelia lucasiana



**Native of:** Brazil

**Habitat:** A lithophyte on rocks in mountains at about 1500m

**Description:** A small plant up to 10cm high with 4cm waxy flowers with 2 to 5 flowers on a 6cm stalk.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow similar species cool (min10°C) in good light, in pots or mounted on bark. We keep them dryish during the winter.

**Flowering season:** Early summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 4yrs
