

Maxillaria sanderiana



Native of: Ecuador and Peru

Habitat: Growing on trees in forest at around 1200m, usually semi-shaded and near rivers.

Description: A medium sized plant with 40cm leaves and single flowers 15cm across.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar species warm (min 15°C) and in pots.

Flowering season: Spring

Flask to flowering approx: 5yrs.
