

Plectreminthus caudatus



Native of: Central and East Africa

Habitat: Epiphytic in forest in bright light.

Description: A medium to large plant with 20-30cm leaves up a stout 15cm stem and flower spikes up to 80cm long with as many as 10 flowers each 7cm across with a 20cm spur.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species in a basket and hot (min18°C) in bright light.

Flowering season: Autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 5yrs
