

Polystachya bella



Native of: Kenya

Habitat: Epiphytic in forest from 1800 to 1950m altitude.

Description: The 4cm pseudobulbs carry up to four leathery leaves. The 20cm flower spike comes from the top of the pseudobulb and carries many primrose scented golden flowers each 2cm long.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow similar plants mounted and in pots and grow it warm (min15°C).

Flowering season: Winter

Flask to flowering approx: 3yrs
