

Prosthechea prismatocarpa



Native of: Costa Rica

Habitat: Epiphytic in open forests up to 1700m.

Description: This is a medium sized plant that with leaves up to 50cm long and dramatic flowers 5cm across borne on 60cm stems with as many as 40 flowers per stem. (This photograph shows the pod parent)

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this species warm (min.15°C) in pots with good light.

Flowering season: Summer

Flask to flowering approx: 5yrs.

Seed source: Writhlington School
