

# Aeranthus ramosa



**Native of:** Eastern slopes of Madagascar

**Habitat:** Up to 1400m on trees in moist rain forest.

**Description:** Dark green 7cm flowers wide on long thin pendulous branching stems up to a meter long.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this warm (min.15°C) And keep it well watered throughout the year in low light. The plant flowers of the same stems for several years, so don't cut old flower stems off.

**Flowering season:** Summer

**Flask to flowering approx:** 4yrs.

**Seedling source:** Bob & Paddy Dadd
